Rafting rates for 3 rivers is \$235+10% tax ( Klickitat, White Salmon and Wind Rivers)

Rafting rates for 2 rivers is \$160+10% tax ( Klickitat and White Salmon Rivers )

Includes \$20 for wine tasting with Sunday lunch after river rafting.

**Timberlake Camp** - 1-509-427-2267, ask for Leroy (pronounced Leroy) and specify Barry/S'no Joke.

Rates are on the web site but tent sites are 20x20 and can accommodate 2 tents, the rate is \$19/day in 2009.  
Expect to pay an extra \$4 for the Sat/Sun reservation of Timberlake Hall.

### May 22, Friday afternoon

Arrive at Timberlake Campground and RV Park. Timberlake has an excellent online tour and video, <http://www.timberlakecampgroundandrvpark.com>. It is about a 4-5 hour car ride from Seattle and is located scenically in the Columbia Gorge. There are optional motels within 30 minutes from the camp.

### May 23, Saturday

After a lusty camp breakfast of your design, meet up at nearby Wet Planet Head Quarters (15 minutes by car) for a full day of Class III rafting on the Klickitat River. Lunch provided as well as helmets, wet suits, PFDs (vests), sweaters, and booties. Wet Planet can accommodate up to 80 on this run and we should be off the river by 5:00.

Dinner is back at camp, again your creation or at nearby restaurants. We have Timberlake Hall, a spacious, partially enclosed hall with fireplace, tables, chairs, and a full kitchen reserved for Saturday and Sunday.

### May 24, Sunday

After yet another lusty camp breakfast of your making, meet at Wet Planet for HALF day of Class III/IV rafting on the White Salmon River. Details as above except a \$20 charge for the optional wine tasting with lunch at the Wind River Cellars Winery -- overlooking the White Salmon Valley with views of Mt. Hood. Supper as before.

### May 25, Monday

Wet Planet will guide up to 20 rafters (should be experienced) on the Wind River. Rafting is Class IV (if water is still high), lunch provided et al as before, off river at 4:00: (Call rafting co. to see if available just before trip)
