## 22nd "Shoot The Pass" Bicycle Winery Tour

June 5 - 7, 2009

Prosser & Zillah, WA



**Friday June 5**, meet at Jim Gayther's 7 AM for Coffee & Donuts, assemble carpools, and caravan to White Pass, via Ohop Bakery. Noon, mount bikes at pass summit and ride 15 miles DOWN White Pass to Trout Lodge for lunch. Those that continue riding, pedal another 15 FLAT miles to the Country Rock Cafe in Naches for refreshments and reassembly of carpools to continue on to Prosser and The Inn at Horse Heaven.

South Sound participants contact Ski Hawks for caravan to White Pass. Riders biking beyond Naches must assure their own support.

Friday evening there will be a hospitality room next to the pool / hot tub, providing snacks and soft drinks, BYOB.

**Saturday**, hotel breakfast provided, then start Prosser area tour at 9:30. Sack lunch provided at Prosser Wine Park near Hogue Cellars. Dinner / Wine Tasting 6:30 PM at Hinerling Winery, \$25 optional for first 25 sign-ups. New Whitstran Brewpub will also be available with a modest priced menu (under \$10).

**Sunday**, hotel breakfast provided, then 9 AM carpool to Zillah. Tour wineries with optional lunch reservation at Bonair Winery, \$12 Tapas Plate. 4 PM finish tour at Claar Cellars to reassemble carpools and depart for home. Silver Lake Winery will have a BBQ till 4 PM, reservation required if arriving after 3 PM. 509-829-6235.

You need not bicycle to participate; there are other recreational activities in the area, and we will need volunteers to drive between White Pass and Trout Lodge. There are many more wineries open to driving visitors in the area.

Hotel is \$99/room each night, 509-786-7977 / 800-688-2192 ask for S'no Joke group, 25 rooms are guaranteed through May 5 so make your reservation now! I will keep a list of singles willing to share a room.

Optional Hinerling Dinner \$25 and Bonair Lunch \$12 must be reserved and paid with your \$20 trip fee by May 27. Trip fee covers hospitality room, Saturday lunch, and SAG Wagon. A signed S'no Joke sign-up / waiver form is required to participate.

Anacortes is much more than just the jumping off point to the San Juan Islands. Discover why on July 10-12! We'll meet Friday afternoon/evening in Old Town Anacortes where our motel will be a few blocks from just about everything.

Saturday we'll do a rolling/hilly 24 or 37 mile ride around Fidalgo Island. After some free time to explore Anacortes by foot or bicycle we'll meet for pizza dinner at a nearby restaurant. There will be entertainment within easy walking distance for the late night crowd. Sunday we'll all catch the ferry to sleepy Guemes Island for a rolling 15 to 20 mile ride. For those who like to get back early you could be home by late afternoon.

The \$130 includes a Friday night dessert reception, two nights lodging, pizza dinner, Guemes Island ferry tickets, bicycle route maps and more information about Anacortes than you'll ever want to know. ## TRIP CANCELLATION POLICIES

The purchaser at no penalty can cancel reservations until 7 days after making the deposit. This grace period, however cannot extend past the final payment due date.

Cancellation made by the purchaser after the grace period will incur a non-refundable reservation fee of \$25 plus any additional charges for any unrecoverable costs; however the total charge shall not exceed the payment received. The purchaser shall be exempt from the non-refundable reservation fee when the trip has changed from what was originally advertised regarding dates, destination, mode of transportation or substantial cost increase (except when the changes are mandated by a commercial vendor or because of changed exchange rates). Refunds for cancellation made by the purchaser shall be processed not later than 45 days after the completion of the trip.

Any purchaser not attending the trip and requesting a refund shall not sell their trip spot and must notify the trip leader of their cancellation. Only the trip leader may sell or resell trip spots. Trip leaders shall follow the priority and waiting list policies as described in the S'no Joke Ski Club's "Trip Activity and Club Polices". Any trip spots that are cancelled by the trip's seller of travel shall be refunded including all recoverable costs (sums paid to the seller of travel for services not performed in accordance with the contract between the seller of travel and the trip leader). These refunds shall be processed not later than 30 days after the receiving the funds from the seller of travel or vendor.

The above fees shall not be modified unless the modifications are stated in the trip announcement and the confirmation letter.

## WAIVER

I recognize that skiing and other activities often involve hazards and risks that may result in injury. In consideration of my participation in this S'no Joke Ski Club activity, I assume all of the risks of the activity and of the related trip, transportation and social activities.
